He works in a variety of formats including painting, video installation, street performance, experimental film, writing and curating. All of his work is connected by an interest in public space, societal structures, the human body, economics, and urban life.

Over the past thirty years Walsh's work and various public projects have been shown at venues in United States, Great Britain, Slovenia and Puerto Rico including at the NARS Foundation Gallery in Brooklyn, New York, The Bronx Museum of Art, Beaconsfield Arts Center in London, England, Gallery P74 in Ljubljana, Slovenia, Socrates Sculpture Park in Queens, New York, School 33 Art Center in Baltimore, Maryland and PSI/MOMA Contemporary Arts Center in Queens, New York. Site specific projects have taken place in Central Park in Manhattan, in San Juan, Puerto Rico, in Hyde Park in London, England, in the Village of Brewster, New York, at the Unisphere in Queens, New York and at other locations.

Walsh was a co-founder and editorial board member of the Baltimorebased arts journal <u>Link</u>, which published ten book length magazines between 1996 and 2006. He has received a variety of grants and awards including one of the final *National Endowment for the Arts* artist fellowships in 1995.
